With many thanks for the kind generosity of **Wise Guys Charity Funds** and **Dan and Sharon O'Hara** and **volunteers at their farm**, we are pleased to announce we have purchased a beautiful handmade cart (\$3,000), tie-down system for a wheelchair, (\$880), 20' container for storage of the cart (\$2,500), harness and other supplies to aid the program startup for riders in wheelchairs. The photo shows not only the happy driver but even the horse looks proud!



This program was initiated about 3 years ago to provide an alternate way for an experience with horses. Some individuals do not wish to ride or are not able and this cart has a removable seat for accommodating either an abled person or a wheelchair. There is a removable ramp for easy access by a wheelchair which is then secured with tie downs. This allows the individual to drive the horse allowing them to develop the same skills as a mounted rider, giving commands such as walking, halting, trotting, going around objects or following different patterns in the ring.
